WHAT? The tenth annual Bellingham Summer Philosophy Conference

WHEN? August 2nd - 6th, 2009

WHERE? Bellingham, Washington

WHO? Everyone in the world is invited to submit a paper, or to volunteer to be a commentator or session chair, but attendance will be primarily limited to those on the conference program.

How? To submit a paper: submissions should be prepared for blind review and emailed to Dennis Whitcomb at dennis.whitcomb@wwu.edu. Papers on any topic are welcome, but some preference will be given to papers that are of general philosophical interest. Papers of any length will be considered, but some preference will be given to shorter papers (<25 pages). The deadline for submissions is March 1st, 2009. Prospective authors will be notified of the Program Committee's decisions in early May.

To volunteer to be a commentator or chair: All volunteers should e-mail Dennis Whitcomb at dennis.whitcomb@wwu.edu. Prospective commentators should indicate their areas of specialty. The deadline for volunteering is March 1st, 2009. Volunteers will be notified of the Program Committee's decisions in early May.

Please note: The BSPC is a workshop-style conference where participants are expected to read all of the papers in advance and to come prepared for discussion. You should not submit a paper or volunteer to comment or chair unless you plan on being a responsible conference participant.
